THE DIRECTOR

Danny Evan Proud attended his first national gymanfa ganu in Saint Paul in 1987. Since then he has been a regular attendee of Welsh language courses and cymanfaoedd canu. Danny has directed cymanfaoedd throughout the Midwest, and since 2002 has led the Cambrian Singers, a Welsh singing group in Madison. He serves on the boards of several Welsh-American organizations and sings with the North American Welsh Choir. In retirement Danny enjoys choral singing, teaching guitar and performing with Vets on Frets and at nursing homes, and he takes harp lessons. He has two children, Leslie and Martin, and lives with his wife Robin in Madison.
